Item 9. Other Events

On June 3, 2022, Xurpas' directors accepted the resignation of Mr. Nico Jose S. Nollo do ("Nix Nollo do") as Chairman of the Board.

Mr. Nix Nollo do's resignation cited personal reasons for his resignation, which will be effective on June 6, 2022. He will remain as an advisor to the Board of Xurpas.

In the same meeting held on June 3, 2022, Xurpas elected a new Chairman, Mr. Jonathan Gerard A. Gurango ("**Joey Gurango**") effective June 6, 2022. Xurpas Board also appointed him as the new Chief Executive Officer effective June 6, 2022. Mr. Joey Gurango's work experience is also provided below:

Business / Professional:

Mr. Joey Gurango has a solid track record in forming and running successful software companies. He was a Support Engineer at Apple Computer from 1982-1984. He was also a Software Developer at Microsoft from 1985 to 1987. He founded Match Data Systems (MDS) in Seattle, USA in 1987, expanded MDS to Philippines and Australia, merged with Great Plains Software in 1999, then acquired by Microsoft in 2001. Mr. Gurango served as the Asia-Pacific Director for Products & Services for Microsoft Business Solutions from 2001 to 2003. He also founded Gurango Software in 2003 as a Microsoft Dynamics partner and sold it to Kation Technologies in 2007. In 2018, he co-founded OfficeGuru, Cognitiv Technologies, and SERVIO Technologies. He has also been a Business Technology Coach by hundreds of startup founders and business owners since 2011.

Civic Affiliations and Awards:

In 2006, the Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship acknowledged him as one of the country's Ten Most Inspiring Technopreneurs. In 2007, he was inducted into the Hall of Fame for Microsoft's Most Valuable Professionals, in recognition of his mastery of software technology and business. Mr. Joey Gurango was also recognized as the Philippines' Ten Most Inspiring Technopreneurs in 2006 by the Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship (Go Negosyo). He co-founded startup incubator SPRING.ph while he was President of the Philippine Software Industry Association in 2013 and 2014. He is also the founder of the Mijares-Gurango Craniofacial Foundation, partner of Operation Restore Hope Australia and Smile Train USA. He is also a founder of the CODE Scholarship Fund.
